## **ADMINISTRATION**

## **Line of Responsibility**

The main operational line of organization for the Lincoln Public School System runs from the Superintendent's Office through the three divisions – Business Affairs (Associate Superintendent for Business Affairs); Instructional Services (Associate Superintendents for Educational Services and Teaching and Learning) and Human Resources (Associate Superintendent for Human Resources). If, for any reason, it is necessary to define an order of rank, the Superintendent will determine that rank. In the absence of the Superintendent and communication from the Superintendent on rank, then the following order shall prevail: Associate Superintendent for Business Affairs, Associate Superintendent for Educational Services, Associate Superintendent for Civic Engagement, Associate Superintendent for Human Resources, Associate Superintendent for Teaching and Learning not including any position that is identified as being an interim position.

The Lincoln Board of Education hereby delegates authority to the Superintendent and authorizes and directs that any actions to be taken or powers or duties to be exercised or performed by the Superintendent as required by or set forth in law, policy, regulation, handbook, collective bargaining agreement, directive or practice, may be delegated or assigned by the Superintendent to another school official, staff member or employee in the Superintendent's discretion to perform the action, power or duty as the Superintendent's designee.

The Board hereby delegates authority to the Associate Superintendent for Educational Services, Associate Superintendent for Business Affairs, Associate Superintendent for Human Resources, Associate Superintendent for Civic Engagement, and Associate Superintendent for Teaching and Learning and authorizes and directs that any actions to be taken or powers or duties to be exercised or performed by these Executive Committee members as required by or set forth in law, policy, regulation, handbook, collective bargaining agreement, directive or practice, may be delegated or assigned by these Executive Committee members to other school officials, staff members or employees in their discretion to perform the action, power or duty as these Executive Committee members' official designee.
